

# Site Selection

Many sites were considered in the Greater Victoria area before selecting the Lot 3A site in Langford. Other than the site's size and topographic characteristics, we require a site to serve members who live in the Victoria area with convenient access to where they live. Our members currently must take a time-consuming and sometime unreliable journey to Vancouver to worship. The Lot 3A site provides excellent transportation connections to the rest of the region and is central to a majority of our Greater Victoria-based members, allowing for a relatively short and reliable journey to the Church.



# Site Details

## 2750 Leigh Road, Langford, BC (Lot 3A)

 Located at the intersection of Leigh Road and Highway 1, the site overlooks Langford Lake and the City of Langford.

### **Development Area**

Gross Site Area: 19,000 SM / 4.70 AC

## **Zoning Analysis**

Existing Zoning: MUE-1

Proposed Zoning: MUE-1

 Proposed Use: Place of Worship (Text Amendment to the Subject Property Zoning)

#### Rationale

- The existing zoning permits a variety of educational, cultural, and recreational uses considered complementary to the proposed inclusion of Place of Worship.
- The proposed use is anticipated to provide a community amenity to the neighbourhood, surrounding area, and municipality, creating a prominent religious facility in Langford.

# **Traffic and Zoning Analysis**

## **Traffic Impact**

- Current zoning regulation (MUE-1) permit several high-traffic uses, including drive-throughs, restaurants, and schools. These activities would generate peak traffic volumes significantly higher than those generated by a Place of Worship.
- · Given the proposed rezoning, no increases in traffic volumes or congestion are anticipated.
